## **ENGINEERING AND COMPUTER SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **Ian Ross Honours Scholarship (Up to four scholarships available of \$5,000):**

- Applicants must have Australian Citizen or Residency status.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a program leading to the award of the degree of Bachelor of Engineering (Honours), Bachelor of Engineering (R&D) (Honours), Bachelor of Software Engineering (Honours), Bachelor of Computer Science (Honours), Bachelor of Advanced Computing (Honours), Bachelor of Advanced Computing (R&D) (Honours) or the Honours Year of Bachelor of Information Technology with Honours.
- Applicants should not hold a scholarship from another source.

## **ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Applicants for Engineering Scholarships listed below must be currently enrolled in a Bachelor of Engineering R&D) (Honours), Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) or any combined degree program with Engineering.
- Scholarships are awarded on academic merit and achievement in extra curricula student projects except where otherwise mentioned.
